Pam,

In the email that you sent you quote: Utah State Election Law 20A-5-405(j)(ii)(A)

....(5) (a) Each election officer shall, without delay, correct any error discovered in any official paper ballot, ballot label, ballot sheet, electronic ballot, or sample ballot, if the correction can be made without interfering with the timely distribution of the paper ballots, ballot labels, ballot sheets, or electronic ballots.

(b) (i) If the election officer discovers an error or omission in a paper ballot, ballot label, or ballot sheet, and it is not possible to correct the error or omission by reprinting the paper ballots, ballot labels, or ballot sheets, the election officer shall direct the poll workers to make the necessary corrections on the official paper ballots, ballot labels, or ballot sheets before they are distributed at the polls.

(ii) If the election officer discovers an error or omission in an electronic ballot and it is not possible to correct the error or omission by revising the electronic ballot, the election officer shall direct the poll workers to post notice of each error or omission with instructions on how to correct each error or omission in a prominent position at each polling booth.

What provisions is the County Clerk making to correct the error of listing me as a candidate in Precinct 2 when I am actually a candidate in District 2?

I am actually a candidate in nine voting precincts, Precinct 2 being one of them.

Mr. Clára,

I have been asked to respond to your email as well as your previous inquiries regarding the designation of Salt Lake City School Board Precinct 2 on the ballot. We confirmed with the Salt Lake City School Superintendent that all of the local districts within that local school district are identified as and named Precinct 1, Precinct 2 and so forth. It is consistent with the school board's long-standing naming and identification practices of these subdivisions within the school district. Further, we have always used of the word 'precinct' to identify a local school board district or precinct on the ballot.

If you feel the statute should be written to clarify whether these local districts within the school districts should be called 'districts' or 'precincts', then legislation can be considered and proposed in the upcoming session in January.
