Dear Mr. Robson:

This letter is in response to your GRAMA request dated June 18, 2013 in which you requested records for the period January 1, 2010 to the present as follows:

- "1. Any correspondence, email or other communication between the office of the Utah State Auditor and any other party regarding the Board of Education of Salt Lake City School District or the Salt Lake City School District (collectively referred to as the "District").
2. Records related to any complaints about the District received by the Office of the Utah State Auditor from any individual or entity.
3. Any documents provided to the Office of the Utah State Auditor under the its hotline program that relate to the District."

We currently have records that are responsive to your request. These records are related to three hotline complaints; therefore, we are unable to provide you with these records for the following reasons:

- For one complaint, the records are part of an ongoing investigation by the Office of the Utah State Auditor and have, therefore, been classified as "protected" pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-2-305(16).
- For one complaint, the Office of the Utah State Auditor made the determination that no investigation was warranted and the matter was closed. These records have been classified as "protected" pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-2-305(10).
- One complaint was referred to the internal auditor at the Utah State Office of Education by the Office of the State Auditor. These records have been classified as "protected" pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-2-305(10).

Pursuant to Utah Code § 63G-2-401, you have the right to appeal the denial of this request to the chief administrative officer, John Dougall, Utah State Auditor. Your notice of appeal must be submitted within 30 days of the above denial date and must include your name, mailing address, daytime telephone number, and an explanation of the relief sought. You may also include any supporting information with your notice of appeal. Your appeal may be submitted at the address listed below.
