The following statement will be emailed to Uintah parents this afternoon.

During the course of the external investigation commissioned by the Salt Lake City School District Board of Education, it was discovered that over \$8,000.00 in Uintah student lunch monies had been misapplied to various student lunch accounts. The funds that were misapplied were either cash or checks; no electronic payments were misapplied. The district has been able to identify some of the affected families, and will be contacting those families in the near future to discuss potential remedies.
