



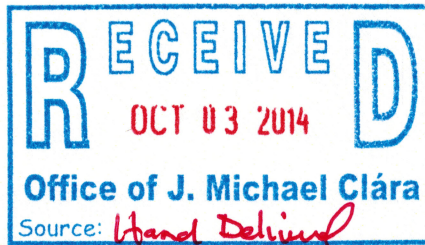

Re: GRAMA Request to Salt Lake City School District Dated 9/19/14

Dear Board Member Clara,

On September 19, 2014, the Salt Lake City School District ("District") received your GRAMA request for documents referring "to Salt Lake City Police Department's participation in investigating the actions of the former Salt Lake City School District employee Shirley Canham." In addition, you specifically requested "the video recording of the police activities at Uintah Elementary on or about April 25, 2014."

In response to your request for documents related to the Salt Lake City Police Department investigation, I am providing you with the requested documents. However, the majority of these documents are protected pursuant to multiple provisions of GRAMA. See, Utah Code Ann. §63G-2-305(10), (16), (18), and (23)(b). As such, you must maintain the confidential nature of these documents and not re-disclose either the documents or their contents.

The portions of the public records that have been redacted are private pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §63G-2-302(2)(d) because the records contain data on individuals the disclosure of which constitutes a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, or are not public documents pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §63G-2-201(3) because the information contains personally identifiable information about students that is protected under the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, 20 U.S.C. §1232g.

In response to your request for the aforementioned video recording, the District retains video recordings for a period of thirty (30) days, at which point they are deleted. As such, I am unable to fulfill that portion of your request.


As we have discussed, because you are a member of the Salt Lake City School District Board of Education, your access to documents is not the same as the general public's access. Accordingly, I am providing you with two distinct sets of documents; one set comprises the documents I would provide to requesting members of the public, and the other set contains the protected information which you are entitled to view based on your position as a board

member. As always, all protected information that is being provided to you as a board member must be kept and maintained in a confidential manner and must not be disclosed.

Pursuant to District Policy C7, Records Management, and its corresponding administrative procedures, you have a right to appeal this decision to the district's chief administrative officer, Janet Roberts. Any such appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days from the date of this letter. An appeal must be initiated by filing a Notice of Appeal, and include the appellants name, mailing address, daytime telephone number and the requested relief. Additional information such as a statement of facts, the basis for appeal, and any supporting legal authority may also be included in your appeal.
