



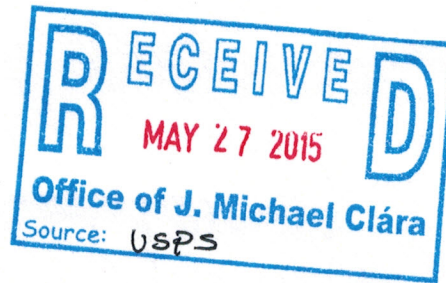

Re: GRAMA Appeal

Dear Board Member Clára:

As the chief administrative officer for the Salt Lake City School District, I received your GRAMA appeal of the district's response to your April 29, 2015, GRAMA request for various "security deployment" documents. Your appeal was based on Utah Code Ann. §63G-2-206 which provides for sharing records between governmental entities. Unfortunately, pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §63G-2-103(11) you, even as an elected local school board member, are not a governmental entity. Moreover, you have provided no statutory or legal reference to support your claim that you are entitled by law to inspect confidential attorney-client privileged communications.

Accordingly, your appeal is denied. Pursuant to Utah Code Ann. §63G-2-402, you may appeal the denial to the records committee or petition for judicial review in district court. Any such appeal must be filed within 30 days of this notice and must be in compliance with §63G-2-404. To file an appeal with the executive secretary of the records committee, include your name, mailing address, daytime phone number, a copy of the denial, and relief sought, to:
